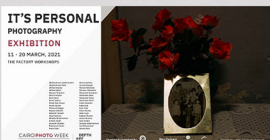

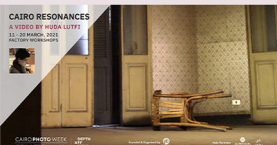

**Cairo Resonances**

Cairo Resonances is the product of a collaborative work with Danish sound artist Jacob Kirkegaard. Normally imperceptible to the ordinary ear, Kirkegaard's explorations of acoustic spaces uncovers an inner world of sound that feels unfamiliar, yet thoroughly captivating. I asked him if we might explore together the sounds of the abandoned courtyard of the Viennoise colonial building situated in the heart of downtown Cairo. As we were commencing the recordings, the adhaan (call to prayer) began to resonate in the air. We agreed to keep the accidental intervention, merging together the echoing sounds of an ostensibly empty space and the resonant voice of one of Cairo's adhaan prayers. The outcome of Kirkegaard's re-recordings of these sounds became the audio background for the visual scenes captured of the building's interior and exterior spaces. Following these echoing and resonating sounds, the camera is made to move slowly through the abandoned spaces of the Viennoise.

Miscegenation –better expressed “metissage” in the French language– is an organic exhibition about personal states of “borderless-ness”, of travel –voluntary and forced–of accumulation and marriage of identities the photographer absorbs in such travels, be it spatial entailing moving between geographies, or temporal entailing the time of travel, and the timelessness of self-travel. Hybrid identities of travelers become “not just” a hermetic thought: the photographer is the traveler.

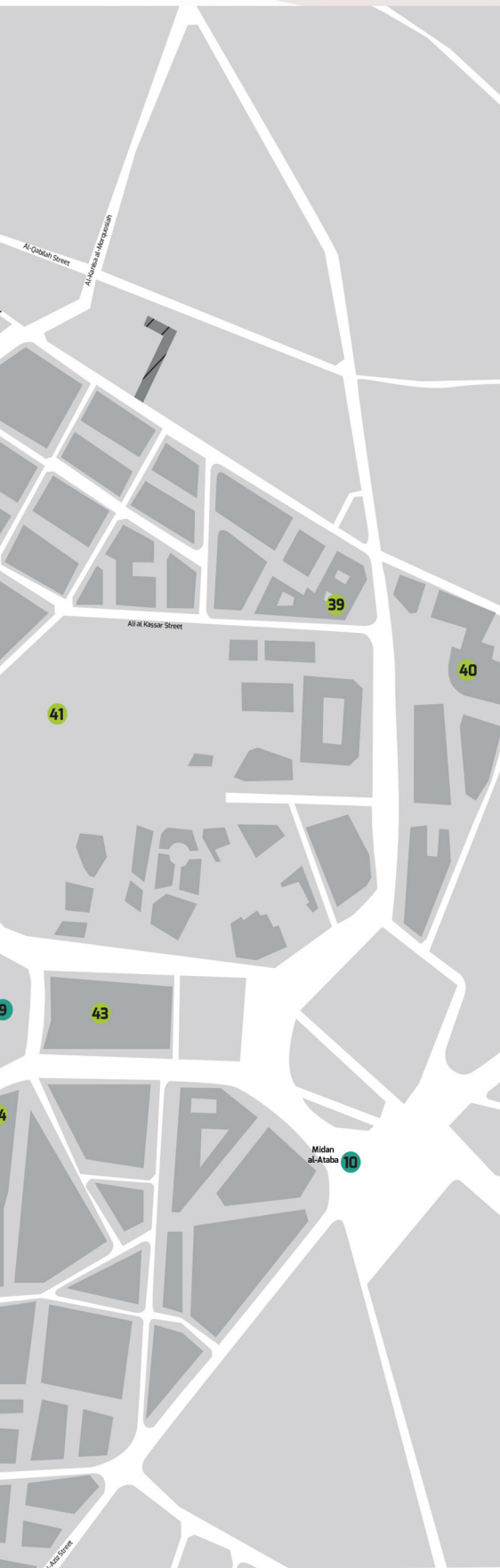
